

### Rules Number Kubb

To play the game you need to be two or more that participate. The more the merrier...

The game can be played on grass or in sand. Choose your playing area and place the number pins (1-12) in a group close to each other, like this for example:

Row 1: 1 & 2  
Row 2: 3 & 10 & 4  
Row 3: 5 & 11 & 12 & 6  
Row 4: 7 & 9 & 8

The distance from the pins to the throwing line measures about four meters.

Pick the throwing order of the players. Each round of the game each player has only one throw. And note that only underarm throws are allowed.

If you knock one number pin down, your score is the number on the fallen pin. If you knock more than one pin down, your score is the total number of knocked down pins. A pin does not count if it isn't horizontal to the grass or sand.

E.g. if you knock 3 pins down, your score is 3 points regardless of the numbers marked on the pins. If you miss all the pins three times in a row you are out of the game.

Before the turn goes to the next player, set all the pins up in exactly the same place they fell. Do not

move them.

The player who first reaches exactly 50 points is the winner!

If you score more than 50 points your score reduces to 25 points as penalty.
